

Voices of Youth Video Project

The video project *Voices of Youth* aimed at giving Tanzanian youth a voice by empowering them to speak out and to visualize their experiences related to sexuality and teenage pregnancy. *Voices of Youth* forms part of the Swiss National Centre of Competence in Research (NCCR) North-South funded research project *Sexual and Reproductive Resilience of Adolescents in Ghana and Tanzania*. Using a participatory action research approach, adolescents (15-19 years) planned, scripted, directed and acted in videos in one urban setting, Dar es Salaam, and one rural setting, Mtwara Town. The youth represented their experiences in two stories. At the same time the process of participatory video production was documented including key findings which inform about interventions that can support youth in dealing with sexuality and teenage pregnancy. The films are complemented by key messages of youth and policy makers.

- 2 Videos by Youth in Mtwara and Dar es Salaam - 17 minutes each
- The Process of Participatory Video Production (incl. key findings) - 12 minutes
- Key Messages by the Youth - 17 minutes
